Notes for Attendees:

- You must attend all 3 days in order to achieve certification.
- Each attendee must bring a KM Helmet, plus tools, and overhaul kit (if required - see below).
- **Please advise the instructor (using email below) of the helmet model that you will be bringing.**
- Bringing an Apeks or Aqualung 1st Stage Regulator will be helpful but not essential.
- **Helmet Overhaul.** Training is largely hands-on and your equipment may be overhauled during the class.

NOTE: If you intend to overhaul a helmet during the class – you must bring the appropriate soft goods overhaul kit with you. Please order in advance – kits will NOT be available at the class.

Certification Validity: Kirby Morgan certification valid 3 years for initial training, 4 years for recertification*.

**NOTE: KM requires that recertification occurs before your existing certificate expires.*
Apeks/Aqualung certification valid 5 years.
