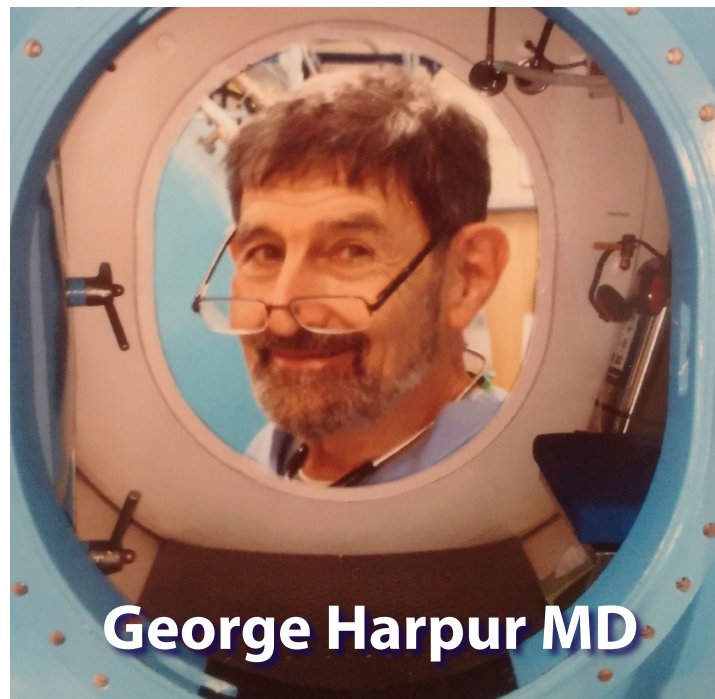

George Harpur is the former Medical Director of the Tobermory Hyperbaric Facility (THF), a post that he held until November 2025. He moved to Tobermory in 1974 and, being well versed in diving medical problems, he took on a supervising role at the facility. He was instrumental in establishing the THF which opened in 1976. During the past 50+ years, Dr Harpur has overseen the evolution and growth of the THF from its primary purpose - dive accident treatment - into a research, training, equipment test, and treatment facility for the additional medical conditions that respond to Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy (HBOT). He is still a practising physician at the THF.

Dr. Harpur's expertise has contributed to the field of hyperbaric medicine with significant advancements in knowledge, and the THF would not have achieved its level of recognition and excellence without him. In addition his guidance and opinion remains sought after by divers and he is considered to be one of the most credible subject matter experts in his field. His advice is always based on sound medical research and real world awareness.

The Canadian diving and hyperbaric industries owe a large debt of gratitude to Dr. Harpur.

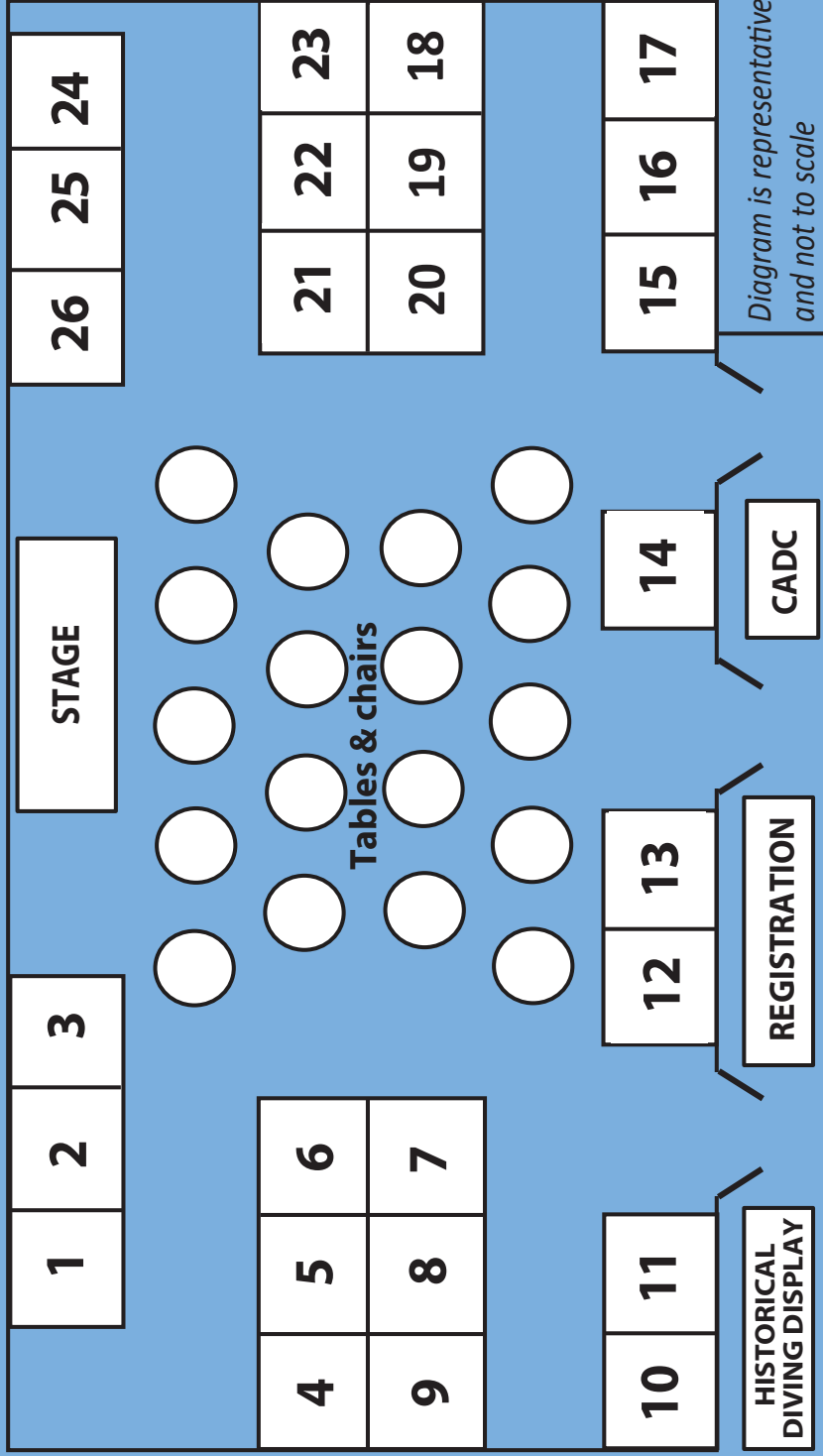
